Dear Parents,

We have taken a measured approach and continue to monitor absences due to illness/COVID. Unfortunately, we are starting to see a rise in the number of COVID cases in the school. Therefore we are temporarily recommending that any student household contact remain at home for 5 days from the start of the symptoms from the family member. It is our hope that this will help curtail the spread of COVID in the school and prevent classes from shifting to online. We had this measure in place earlier and feel that it is an additional measure to prevent the spread.

We appreciate all of your support in ensuring that our students continue to learn in person. We know we all want things to be back to normal and are tired of additional measures. We thank you in advance for keeping your students home when sick and when in close contact with a family member in the same household with COVID.
