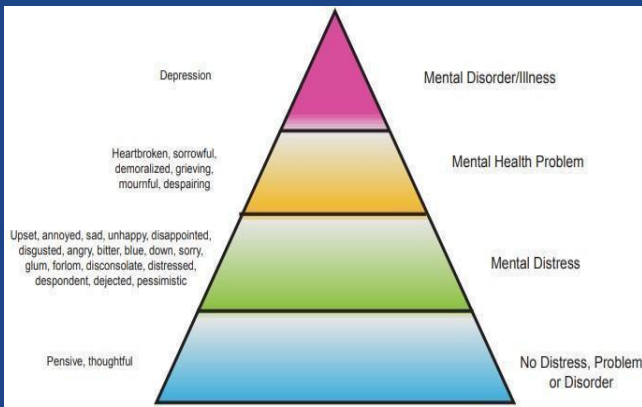

What is the Social Emotional Coach (SEC) Program?

The SEC program provides leadership, short term counselling (skills/strategies) to students, and coaching to grow students, families and teachers' capacity in the area of social-emotional health and wellness.

SEC team members are available to assist and support students, and their corresponding families, with a wide range of social, emotional and/or behavioral challenges. SEC team members possess the skills necessary to facilitate a number of other services and supports, including: consultation with multidisciplinary teams; student, family, staff, and/or small group facilitation; and school staff professional development, etc. with the approval of the Director of Inclusive Learning.
