Are You Travelling Out of Canada for Winter Break?

If you answered yes to this question, than you'll need to know the current guidelines. Please go to Covid-19 Requirements for Travellers for more information; below is an excerpt from these guidelines:



Requirements for an unvaccinated child less than 12 years of age

For 14 days after arrival, the child must not:

- attend school, camp or day care
- attend a setting where they may have contact with vulnerable people (e.g., long-term care facility), including people who are immunocompromised, regardless of that person's vaccination status or public health measures
- travel on crowded public transportation that does not ensure physical distancing and masking
- attend large crowded settings, indoors or outdoors, such as an amusement park or sporting event

We thank our families in advance for helping keep our school community healthy in the new year by following these guidelines.

Polar Bears

In the Davis Strait, the polar bear's primary food source is the harp seal. Sadly, as the sea ice is disappearing, harp seals are becoming less abundant and without them, polar bears would not survive! That's why Earth Rangers is working with University of Alberta researcher Larissa Thelin on a project that will use satellite radio tracking to see where both harp seals and polar bears spend their time, and more importantly, where their habitats overlap – this is where polar bears will have the easiest time finding food! Then, with the help of over 40 years of sea ice data, Larissa will be able to create predictions about how these important areas will be affected as climate change continues to cause sea ice to disappear.
