Congratulations!

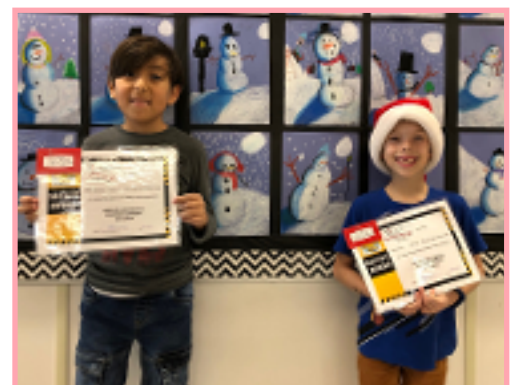

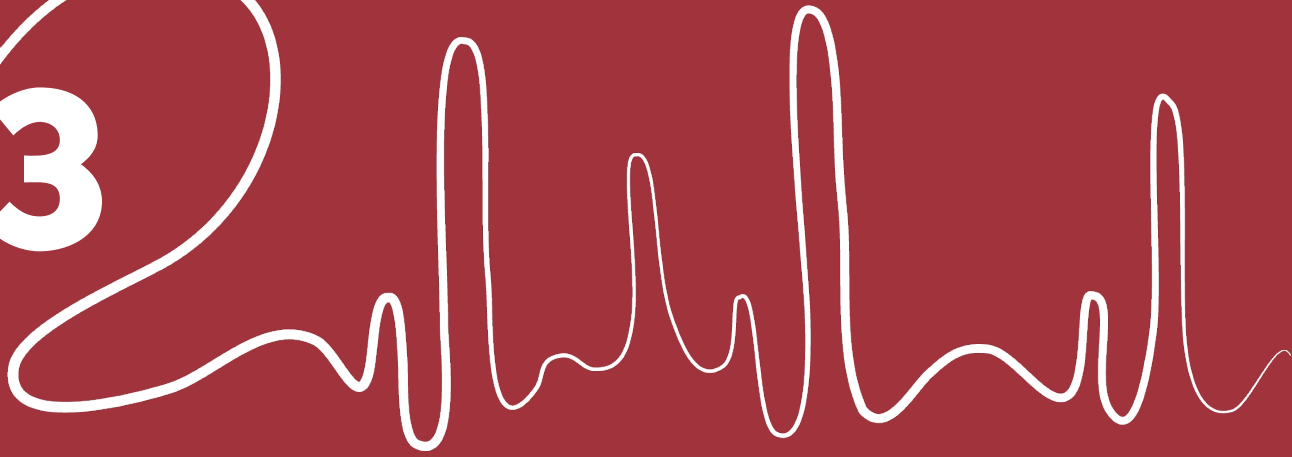

Jump Rope for Heart!

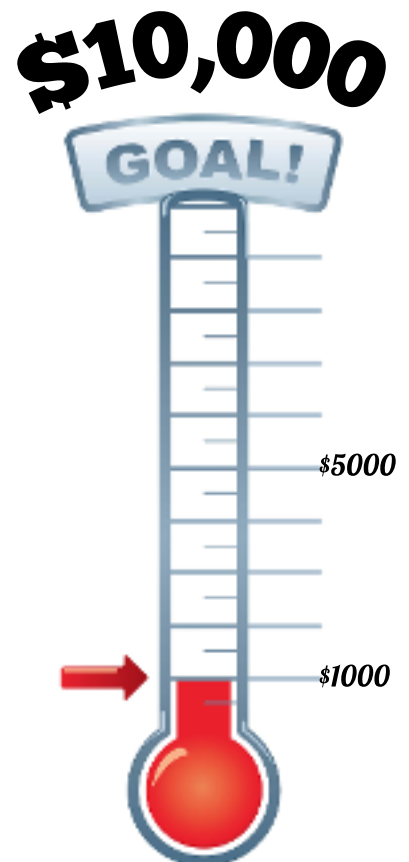
Every year our students in grades 4, 5, and 6, learn the importance of living a healthy life, staying active, and giving back to their community through the Heart and Stroke Foundation's Jump Rope for Heart Program. On February 16th we will take part in our 33rd Jump Rope for Heart!

During the past 32 years, our students have raised more than \$410,000 for Heart and Stroke research and education through all the pledges received. This year our goal is to raise \$10,000. To help us reach this goal, students are encouraged to ask their family and friends if they would be willing to pledge them for this cause. We don't want students going door to door for the health and safety of everyone in our school and community, however, you can definitely phone or email everyone you know.

As an incentive, for every \$10 a student raises in pledges, they will earn a bounty prize ticket that they can then place in a draw for the prize of their choice. Winners will be drawn at the end of our event. These prizes are sponsored by Armstrong's Clothing and Sports, Wainwright Canadian Tire, Huxley Hockey Conditioning, Sportfactor in Edmonton, our Phys. Ed. program, and the WES Learning Commons. They will be displayed in the Learning Commons window for all to see.
