Digital Report Cards

Digital Report cards for students in Grades 1 to 6 are available to view through your Parent Portal account. Keep in mind you must be logged into your account on a computer to see the report card, as this is not an option through the app.

If you don't have a computer, you can request a copy of your child's report card through the school office at <u>wes@btps.ca</u> or phone us at (780) 842-3361.

Parent Portal Account

Parent Portal is the program we use to digitally report grades, attendance, and fees for students in Grades 1 to 6. If you don't have a Parent Portal Account or are not sure if you do, phone the school office and we will help you. We can even help get you logged back into an existing account if you've forgotten your username and password.

PowerSchool Mobile App

The app is a convenient way to stay logged into your Parent Portal account on your devices. It makes it easy to stay informed about your child's progress throughout the year, not just at the end of a reporting period. If you do decide to download the app, you will need the district code GFST. You will need to have an account set up before you download the app. Let us know if you'd like more information.

School Fees

Fees for the current school year are \$60 for students in Kindergarten and \$120 for students in Grades 1 to 6.

Our division office has been emailing invoices to our parents monthly since the end of September. If you haven't been receiving their emails, please contact us as soon as possible. It could be that we have the wrong email address for you on file and we need to fix it, or maybe it's something else.

Fees can be paid at the school with cash or cheque, or etransferred to <u>wes@btps.ca</u>. If you're using e-transfer make sure you put your child's name, school year that you're paying for, and "school fees" in the message.

Little Leaders 3 Year Old's

To attend Little Leaders, children must turn 3 years old on or before December 31, 2022, for the upcoming school year.

Families can choose from one of three half day programs: Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday mornings from 9:10 to 11:40 am. Classes are limited to 12 children, but more classes will be made available if there is a need for it in our community.

Little Leaders is an affordable early education program for 3 year old's with a minimal cost to parents.

Wainwright Pre-K 4 Year Old's

To attend Wainwright Pre-K, children must turn 4 years old on or before December 31, 2022 for the 2022/2023 school year.

Families can choose from one of four half day programs: Monday & Wednesday mornings or afternoons, and Tuesday & Thursday mornings or afternoons. Mornings run from 9:00 am to 11:30 am, and afternoons are 12:30 pm to 3:00 pm. Classes are limited to 12 or 13 children, but more classes will be made available if needed. This is an affordable program for 4 year old's with a minimal cost to parents.

Our class sizes are kept small, so more programs will be added if there is a need for it.
