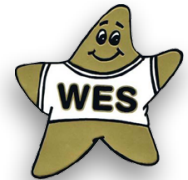
## ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

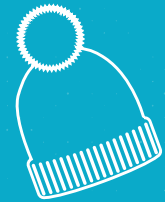

Thank you to our families who have already contacted us, please let us know if there's anything you need from us to register your children in their new school.

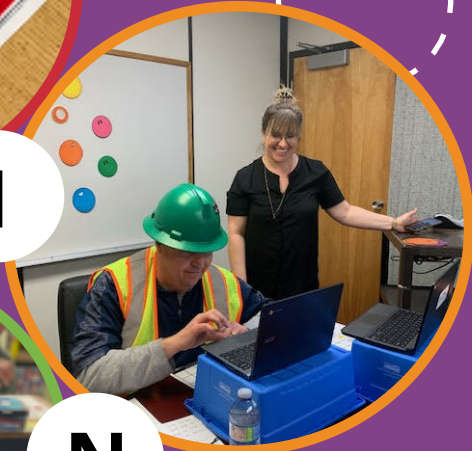

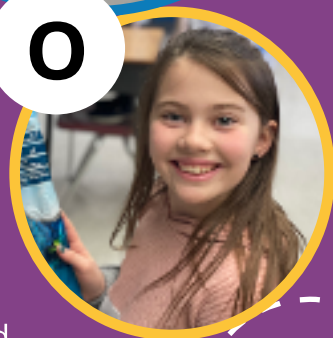

# Quiet! EXAM IN PROGRESS



Earlier in the year we shared with our parents that grade 6 students would be writing PAT's this year. The tests will take place on:

- May 18 - ELA Part A
- June 14 - ELA Part B
- June 15 - Science
- June 22 - Math
- June 24 - Social Studies

Parents can help their children by ensuring they get a good night's sleep, start their day with a healthy breakfast, and arrive at school by 8:35 am, so that they have time to get settled before the tests start. Tests start at 9:00 am, please don't be late.

## School Fees

Final notices for school fees were emailed out at the end of April, or mailed to families we do not have email addresses for. Families will have until the end of May to pay them. If left unpaid, they will be sent to collections by our Board Office. School Fees this year were \$60 for Kindergarten and \$120 for Grades 1 to 6. Payments can be made in person at the school with cheque or cash, or through e-transfer to wes@btps.ca. If sending fees by e-transfer make sure you put your child's name and the school year you're paying for in the message.

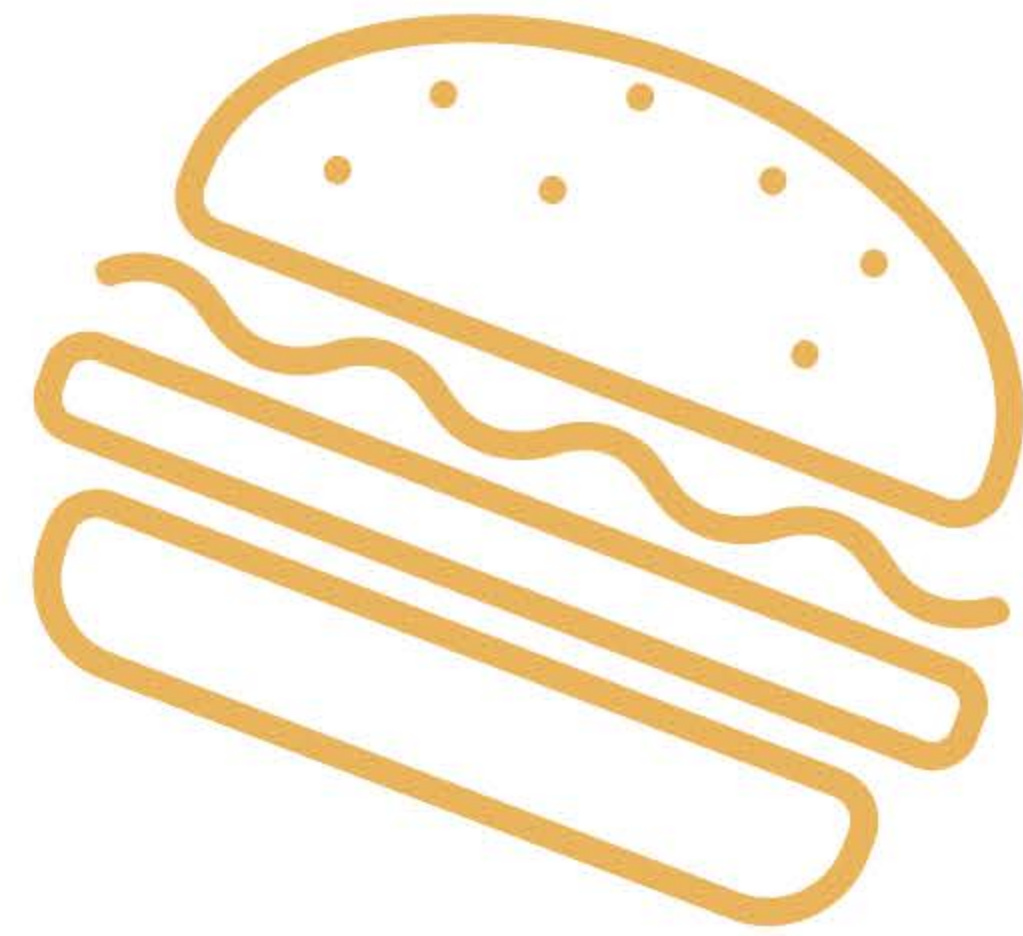

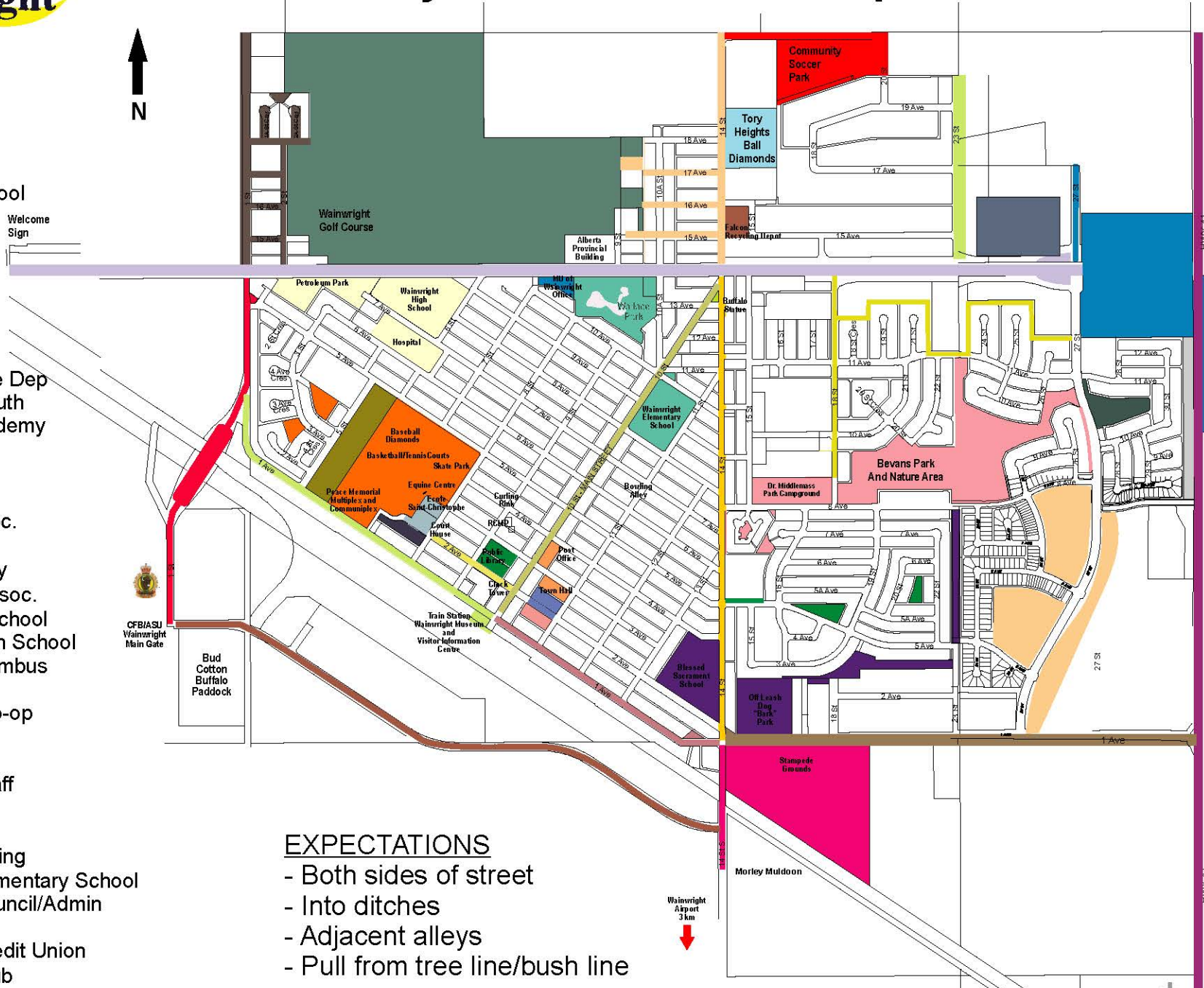

## Town Map



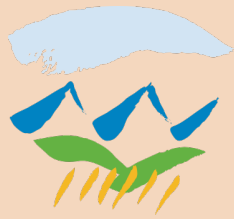
