


#### Volleyball

### School Fees for 2022/2023

Within the next couple of weeks BTPS will assign school fees for the year. Invoices are emailed at the end of each month. Fees for students in kindergarten will be \$30 for the year, and for grades 1 to 6 will be \$60. These fees will go toward BTPS Supplemental Supports and BTPS Technology Fees.

#### **Payment Methods:**

- At the school with cash, cheque, or postdated cheques. We do not have a debit/credit machine.
- With PayPal through our website at <a href="https://wes.btps.ca/pay-fees">https://wes.btps.ca/pay-fees</a>. You will need your child's Alberta Student Number (ASN). If you don't know it, please contact the school office.
- E-transfer to wes@btps.ca. You don't need to set up a password because we have autodeposit enabled. Please put your child's name and school year you're paying for in the message.





#### Parent Portal

For anyone new to our school, the Parent Portal program is used by our teachers and Buffalo Trail Public Schools division office to report student grades, attendance, school fees, and if applicable, bus fees.

New families will automatically receive an email by the end of September with the information you need to set up your account.

Families who were with us last year, and have lost the email they received can contact the school office and we will help you get your account set up.

Once you have your account set up, you can go to your app store and download the PowerSchool Mobile App. The district code they'll ask you for is GFST. The app is a really convenient tool for checking to see how your child is doing in school.

Paper report cards are not sent out during the year, so, to see your child's grades throughout the year, or to print off a mid-year report card, you will need to have an account. To print a report card, you need to be logged into a computer, as it's not currently an option through the app.

Last year we did send out a year-end report card which we heard our families appreciated, so we will continue sending home a report card on the last day of school in June.



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

The first day for students is **August 30th**, **2022**. **February 1st**, **2023** is the first day of Term 2. **June 27th**, **2023** is the last day of school for students.

Please be reminded that when inclement weather does not allow us to operate our buses, schools will be open, classes are occurring and student learning continues. As with any absence, students who miss material will be provided with an opportunity to receive instructional material through an alternate means or catch up on missed school work upon return to school.

Students are required to be in attendance until the last day of school as identified by the BTPS Board Approved Calendar. Final exams at the Grade 7 to 9 level will occur during the last five student days each semester. During non-examination times, tutorials, course review and alternate activities will occur. Final exams in non-diploma courses at the Grade 10 to 12 level will occur during the last five student days each semester. During non-examination times, tutorials, course review and alternate activities will occur. Final exams in diploma courses will occur as described in the Alberta Education Diploma exam schedule (<a href="https://www.education.alberta.ca">www.education.alberta.ca</a>) and submission of marks will occur the day prior to the diploma marks submission date. During non-examination times, tutorials, course review and alternate activities will occur.

The total student days in this year's calendar equals 181 days.
