Through this valuable program our students in Grades 4, 5, and 6 learn the importance of living a healthy lifestyle, about giving back to their community, and how to recognize the signs of a stroke and what to do in case of emergency.

This is our 34th year of being a part of the Heart and Stroke Foundation Jump Rope for Heart program. In that time our staff and students have raised over \$432,000 for Heart and Stroke Research and Education. So far, we have raised \$6600, and counting, toward our goal of \$10,000.
