

MILK TICKETS ARE BACK - MARCH 13

We've had requests from parents to bring back milk tickets, so starting on March 13th, parents who would prefer to buy tickets in bulk rather than sending money to school daily, are welcome to stop by the office to purchase them. Please do not send large amounts of money with your child to school. If you cannot make it into the office to buy the tickets yourself, you can etransfer wesebtps.ca. For e-transfer, please include in the message: Milk Tickets, your child's name, and the number of tickets you are purchasing. Tickets are \$1.00 each, booklets are 10 tickets for \$10. We encourage students to write their names on the their tickets, since we won't be reusing them.

PLEASE NOTE: Our classrooms are very busy places, so going forward teachers will not be keeping milk money or tickets in their classroom to keep track of. Purchased tickets will be sent home. Parents can decide whether or not they want to keep them in their child's backpack (mail bag for the younger grades), or keep them at home to send in when your child wants milk.. The Powerschool Mobile App allows parents the convenience of checking Parent Portal online, however if you want to print a copy of the report card, you will need to be logged into your account on a computer.
