Grade 1's are travelling to Paradise Valley on June 7th to visit the Climb Thru Time Museum. After they tour the museum, they'll return to Wainwright for a picnic at Wallace Park. The bus will leave WES at 9:10 am. Students will be back at the school for the end of the school day in time for the last bell and buses.
